


First of all, don't despair! It's not the end of the world. Here are some things you can do:




## WRITE THE SUPPLEMENTARY **EXAMS**

These happen in June. You can only do this if:











## **RE-MARKING OR RE-CHECKING** YOUR EXAM

If you feel that your exam has been unfairly or incorrectly marked, you can apply to have it re-marked or re-checked.

- The application deadline is 19 January.
- It costs **R92** for a re-mark.
- It costs **R21** for a re-check.
- It costs **R180** for viewing your exam after it's been re-marked or re-checked.





#### **RE-DO MATRIC**

You can re-do matric at your high school or through a bridging course. There is absolutely no shame in doing this to get your National Senior Certificate.



#### DO A BRIDGING COURSE



This is a short course that allows a matriculant to redo matric subjects and get a solid pre-degree/diploma foundation. You can also catch up on subjects that you didn't take but need for tertiary.
